The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.0034 dated 10.4.2018 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 324, 323, 341, 506, 34 of Indian Penal Code (for short, "IPC") and 326 IPC added later on at Police Station Sadar Faridkot, District Faridkot.

Heard.

Learned counsel for petitioners submits that it is a case of version and cross-version between the parties.

A bare perusal of the MLR of injured Harpreet Singh son of Tarlok Singh transpires that he has suffered six injuries, out of which, one incised wound on the front of right leg was found to be grievous. Remaining injuries were simple in nature and have been caused with blunt weapons.

The petitioners are in custody since 16.6.2018.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and

keeping in view the fact that conclusion of trial will take considerably long time, the present petition is allowed. The petitioners are ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of concerned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, subject to following terms:-

- (a) The petitioners shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.
- (b) In the event of their absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioners shall stand withdrawn. The trial Court shall be competent to cancel their bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure their presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioners shall have to apply for bail afresh.
- (c) They shall not leave the country without the previous permission of the Court.
