This is a second petition for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.345 dt. 07.12.2014, registered at Police Station, Dharamkot, District Moga, under Sections 406 and 420 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner could not appear before the trial Court earlier as there was no protection from arrest. Moreover, the petitioner has associated himself with all enquiries conducted by various other agencies and is not absconding. He wants to join the trial, but without fear of threat of arrest.

Notice of motion. Mr. J.S. Walia, Sr. DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State of Punjab. Let two copies of the petition be supplied to him during the course of the day.

The petition is disposed of with direction to the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court on the date fixed i.e. 30.07.2018, and move an application for regular bail. On his doing so, the trial Court shall grant him regular bail subject to its satisfaction.
