The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to petitioner-Kapil @ Sonu in case FIR No.130 dated 21.03.2018 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 395, 397, 452 of Indian Penal Code (for short, "IPC") and Section 25 of Arms Act (report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. presented under Sections 395, 397, 452, 120-B IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act) at Police Station City, Narnaul, District Mohindergarh.

Heard.

It has been submitted that no role has been attributed to the petitioner. Only it is alleged that he was connived with the attacking party. He is in custody since 12th April, 2018

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that conclusion of trial will take considerably long time, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of

trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned subject to following terms:-

- (a) The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.
- (b) In the event of his absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial Court shall be competent to cancel his bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure his presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh.
- (c) He shall not leave the country without the previous permission of the Court.
