Prayer in the instant petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for a direction to respondent Nos.1 to 4 to investigate FIR No.236 dated 09.06.2015 under Section 420, 406 IPC, registered at Police Station Safidon, District Jind.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that despite FIR having been registered on 09.06.2015, fate of the said FIR is yet not known to the petitioner and to expedite the investigation, he has been consistently requesting respondent Nos.1 to 4, but no action has been taken so far.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 4 only at this stage.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Anmol Malik, A.A.G., Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents no.1 to 4.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has contended that he has been approaching respondent Nos.1 to 4 to expedite the investigation, but there is no such representation on record to substantiate the aforesaid contention.

However, without commenting anything on merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent Nos.1 to 4 that in case the petitioner submits a representation to the S.P. concerned within a period of 15 days from today, respondent Nos.1 to 4 shall take note of the said representation and will act in accordance with law.

Disposed of accordingly.
