Today at the very outset, learned State counsel has filed affidavit of Sh. Pawan Kumar, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Detective, Jind on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. The said reply is accompanied by a copy of statement of respondent No.4-Rajbir father of petitioner No.2 wherein he has stated that his daughter Preeti Devi-petitioner No.2 is at liberty to reside where she wants and they have no objection in this regard. It is further stated therein that they shall not harm petitioner No.2-Preeti.

Today Ms. Kamaldeep Kaur, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondent No.4-Rajbir and has filed power of attorney, which is taken on record.

Respondent No.4-Rajbir as well as his wife are present in the Court and prayed that and they be permitted to meet petitioner No.2 for a short while. Acceding to their request they were permitted to meet petitioner No.2. Thereafter, the learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that as of now the petitioners do not apprehend any threat to their lives and liberty.

In view of the aforesaid position, the petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous. However, the petitioners are at liberty to file fresh petition at a later stage if ever they apprehend any threat to their life and liberty.
