The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 240 dated 09.03.2018, registered under Sections 21, 25 and 29 of the NDPS Act at Police Station City Karnal, District Karnal.

The operative part of the order dated 27.07.2018, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner was not named in the FIR and his name surfaced in the FIR on the basis of the disclosure statement of Vijay Kumar. It is further submitted that the aforesaid Vijay Kumar, has been granted the relief of interim anticipatory bail awaiting the report of FSL vide order dated 05.07.2018 passed in CRM-M No.25909 of 2018. It is further submitted that till date the report of FSL has not been received. Counsel for the petitioner has further argued that another co-accused namely Kuldeep, whose name was also disclosed by the other co-accused after their arrest, has also been granted the concession of interim

anticipatory bail vide order dated 30.05.2018 passed in CRM-M No.23723 of 2018.

Notice of motion for 14.09.2018.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 27.07.2018, has already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Rohtash, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 27.07.2018, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
