This petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for issuance of appropriate direction to the official respondents to conduct the investigation in case Rapat No. 27 dated 17.08.2017, Police Station Mukandpur, District S.B.S. Nagar.

Upon notice, status report, by way of affidavit of Mr. Harwinder Singh, PPS, DSP, Sub Division, Banga, has been filed on behalf of respondent-State. In the status report, it is stated that the matter has been investigated and on 21.08.2017, Rajveer Kaur, i.e. Daughter-in-law of petitioners No. 1 and 2, came to the police post and met the person-in-charge and recorded her statement that she had left her matrimonial home on account of the domestic disturbances in the said house. She further stated that she had left and gone to Amritsar where she stayed in Gurudwara Harmandir Shaib for two days. Thereafter, she left Amritsar and has gone back to her parents' house and did not want to go back to her matrimonial

home.

In view of the fact that the daughter-in-law of petitioners No. 1 and 2 is residing at her parental home, no further orders are called for in the present matter and the petition is disposed of accordingly.
