1. In the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. filed by the petitioner, prayer has been made for issuance of directions to official respondents to protect his life and liberty at the hands of private respondents No.6 and 7.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners, at the very outset, contends that the purpose of the instant petition would be achieved, if respondent No.2-Senior Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga, is directed to decide representation (Annexure P-7), moved by the petitioner.

In view of the above, respondent No.2-Senior Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga, is directed to look into the matter and decide representation (Annexure P-7), moved by the petitioner, in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order and after affording an opportunity of hearing to him, within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. The instant petition stands disposed of, accordingly.
