Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0098 dated 22.06.2018 under Sections 420 and 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Mandi Gobindgarh, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

Mr. Munish Kamboj, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of the complainant and filed his *vakalatnama* in Court which is taken on record.

Pursuant to order dated 27.07.2018 of this Court, counsel for the petitioner has handed over a demand draft of Rs.25,000/- to counsel for the complainant in Court. Counsel for the complainant has accepted the demand draft and has given it to the complainant-Bhupinder Kaur, who is present in Court.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Gurbachan Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined investigation and his custody is no more required.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Considering the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation and his custody is no more required, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 27.07.2018 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when directed by the investigating agency and shall abide by the terms and conditions laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
