Prayer in the instant petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. has been made for grant of regular bail to petitioner Bijender @ Ranga in a case arising from FIR No.11 dated 13.01.2018 under Sections 323/452/307/34 IPC, later on added Sections 193/202/120-B IPC and Sections 25/54/59 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Sadar Gohana, District Sonapat.

According to the prosecution, in the evening of 12.01.2018, the petitioner inflicted gun shot injury on the right leg of the complainant Dharambir, who is a salesman on a liquor vend. The petitioner, after arrest in another case under Arms Act, made a confessional statement that he was partner in the liquor vend, where the occurrence took place and he and the complainant Dharambir both consumed liquor and thereafter, some altercation took place between them. Resultantly, the petitioner caused fire injury to the complainant.

Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that one of the material witnesses has turned hostile during trial. The conclusion of trial

shall take a long time.

Considering over-all facts and circumstances, but without

expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. Consequently, petitioner is ordered to be released on bail, on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds, to the satisfaction of Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
