Petitioners have preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.270 dated 16.06.2018, registered under Sections 323, 341, 380, 353, 186, 34 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Manimajra, Chandigarh.

Learned State counsel has stated that the petitioners have joined the investigation; nothing is to be recovered from them and they are no more required for custodial interrogation.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in the present case. Ordered accordingly.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 27.07.2018, passed by this Court, is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
