Through this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. prayer has been made for grant of regular bail to petitioner Harpreet Singh alias Raja in a case arising from FIR No.64 dated 04.04.2018 registered under Section 21 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.

Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that FSL report has not yet been received. Therefore, it cannot be said at this stage that alleged recovered powder was a narcotic substance. Petitioner is in custody since 04.04.2018.

In view of above, but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petitioner is granted interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and two sureties of ₹2.00 lakh each, to the satisfaction of Special Court concerned only till receipt of the FSL report.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
