The present petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No.0048 dated 02.06.2017, registered at Police Station Fattu Dyinga, Kapurthala, District Kapurthala, under Sections 323, 325, 341, 148, 149 IPC on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2).

Pursuant to order dated 11.12.2017, report dated 03.02.2018 has been received from Sh.
