Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.75 dated 10.07.2018 registered under Sections 365, 323, 148, 506 IPC at Police Station City II Malerkotla, District Sangrur.

Vide order dated 27.07.2018 while issuing notice of motion for today i.e. 28.08.2018, the arrest of the petitioner was stayed.
