Present petition has been filed for seeking anticipatory bail in Complaint NACT No.417 of 2016 dated 13.06.2016 titled as *Rajinder Kumar Garg vs. Kuldeep* for the offence punishable under Section 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner could not appear on the date fixed before the Trial Court because the petitioner had noted the wrong date. Thereafter, petitioner came to know that the bail bonds of the petitioner has been canceled and warrants of arrest has been issued against him. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that although earlier also, the bail bonds of the petitioner were canceled, however, subsequently the Court had granted bail to the petitioner when it was apprised that the petitioner had undergone minor surgery and therefore, he could not appear.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has no intention to flee from the course of justice. The only prayer made is

that the petitioner be protected against arrest.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Shri Surinder Singh, A.A.G, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the State. Learned counsel does not oppose the prayed made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the above, without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. It is directed that in case the petitioner appears before the Trial Court on or before 31.08.2018, then he shall be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds/surety to the satisfaction of the Trial Court.
