Affidavit of Sh. Rajdeep Singh, SHO, Police Station Sector-39, Chandigarh, has been filed in Court and is taken on record. A copy thereof has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner. A perusal thereof shows that complaint under Section 156(3) Cr. P.C. preferred by Krishana (mother of the petitioner) has been rejected by the trial Court. Consequently, no FIR has been registered against the complainant side. The Investigating Officer has also shown the MLR of the petitioner, accordingly to which the petitioner has suffered two injuries which are abrasions, one on the right parietal region and the other on the left index finger. Thus, the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner had received seven stitches on his head is apparently incorrect.

Learned State counsel submits that the petitioner has meanwhile been declared proclaimed offender.

In view of the above, the petition has no merits and is dismissed.
