In the instant petition, petitioner has sought for anticipatory bail under the provisions of Section 438 Cr.P.C in case FIR No.167 dated 28.06.2018 registered under Section 61/1/14 Punjab Excise Act, 1914 at Police Station Phillaur, District Jalandhar.

2. Police officials have seized vehicle bearing registration No.PB-32-P-4081 Bolero Pick Up which contains 33 boxes of English Wine King Gold, 36 boxes of Whisky Rajdhani and 60 boxes of high speed whisky wherein it is mentioned that it is sale in Chandigarh only. Such material is being transported. After seeing the police officials, Driver of the vehicle left the vehicle and ran away from the spot.

3. Petitioner has not disputed that he is owner of the aforesaid vehicle.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that petitioner has been falsely implicated. Police officials have planted the liquor in his vehicle. Therefore, he is entitled to anticipatory bail.

5. Petitioner has failed to apprise this Court what was the animosity between the petitioner and particular police official so as to

implicate petitioner in such offence. In the absence of necessary material that petitioner has been implicated falsely, Court cannot apprise the contention that petitioner had been implicated falsely.

6. Accordingly, the petitioner is not entitled for anticipatory bail.

7. Hence, petition stands dismissed.
