This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. with a prayer to issue necessary directions to respondents No.2 to 3 not to harass the petitioner at the instance of respondent No.4 and to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner as well as to look into the representation-Annexure-P1.

Notice of motion was issued in this matter and status report by way of an affidavit of Anil Kumar Kohli, PPS, DSP Sub Division City Hoshiarpur has been filed in Court today.

Status report has been filed. As per the status report, it is submitted that the representation of the petitioner was looked into. The inquiry has been entrusted by the SSP Hoshiarpur to Inspector Kamlesh Kumari, E.O. Wing, Hoshiarpur who investigated the matter and got the victim (minor girl) medico legally examined and also got her statement recorded under Section 164 Cr.P on 16.10.2018.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent-State submits that after due investigation, offences under Section 376, 120-B IPC read with Section 12 of the POCSO Act have been added to the present FIR and additional accused have also been nominated.

In view of the status report that has been filed and the action being taken thereon, learned counsel for the petitioner after arguing at some length, does not press the same.

Disposed of accordingly, having been rendered infructuous.
