The petitioner-Sanjeev Kumar, seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 90, dated 23.07.2017, registered at Police Station City Hoshiarpur, under section 307 IPC and section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner has been in custody since 31.10.2017. The allegation is that he along with co-accused fired at the complainant party but no injury was caused to any one. The investigation is complete and no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner in custody indefinitely.

The prayer is opposed by learned State counsel on the ground that three empty cartridges were recovered from the spot and the petitioner is also accused in another case under sections 379-B, 506 IPC and section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959.

Keeping in view the fact that the investigation is complete and that the

alleged weapon has not been recovered till date and that the trial of the case will take some time to be concluded, I deem it appropriate to grant regular bail to the petitioner.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the petitioner- Sanjeev Kumar son of Desh Raj, is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court concerned at Hoshiarpur.
