Petitioner seeks benefit of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.211, dated 16.09.2016, under Section 22 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Kotwali Bathinda, District Bathinda.

As per prosecution version, the alleged recovery of 15 bottles of Rexcof (100 ml each) was effected from the petitioner.

The recovery would be construed to be commercial in nature.

Even otherwise, learned State counsel upon instructions from HC Jaswant Singh apprises the Court that the trial is at the concluding stage inasmuch as out of 11 prosecution witnesses cited, 6 have been examined and 4 have been given up.

Under such circumstances, the instant petition is disposed of as not pressed at this stage.
