In the present petition, petitioners are seeking quashing of FIR No. 107, dated 16.07.2018, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 326, 324, 341 IPC, registered at Police Station Baragudha, District Sirsa along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 23.07.2018 (Annexure P/2).

2. This Court while ordering notice of motion, had directed the parties to appear before the trial Court / Illaqa Magistrate for the purpose of recording their statements with regard to veracity of the compromise. The Judicial Magistrate First Class, Sirsa has sent his report dated 20.08.2018 wherein it is stated that in pursuance to the order of this Court, statements of the parties were recorded. As per the statements, compromise has been effected without any fear or undue influence.

3. In view of the law laid down in ***Anita Maria Dias and another***

**vs. State of Maharashtra and another** reported in **(2018) 3 SCC 290**, no useful purpose will be served by continuing the criminal proceedings. Therefore, present petition is allowed and FIR No. 107, dated 16.07.2018, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 326, 324, 341 IPC, registered at Police Station Baragudha, District Sirsa along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby set aside qua the petitioners subject to payment of litigation cost of Rs. 3,000/- by each of the petitioner to the Treasury, State of Haryana within a period of three months from today.
