The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking a direction to the official respondents to take appropriate action and conduct a fair and prompt investigation against the persons arrayed as accused in complaint dated 13.7.2018 (Annexure P/2).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that at the moment he will be satisfied in case the representation of the petitioner dated 13.7.2018 (Annexure P/6) that has been filed is decided expeditiously, keeping in view the gravity of the allegations made therein.

Notice of motion to the official respondents.

At this stage, on the asking of the court Ms. Seena Mand, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents and submits that official respondents will look into the matter and will decide the

representation of the petitioner within a period of two weeks, on receipt of certified copy of this order. Let sufficient number of copies of the paper book be supplied to him during the course of the day, failing which no action will be called for.

In view of the above, the instant petition is disposed of by directing the official respondents to decide the representation dated 13.7.2018 (Annexure P-6) of the petitioner within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.

The petition stands disposed of in the above-said terms.
