The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking a direction to respondent No.3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and her family members at the hands of respondents No. 6 to 8.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that no action is being taken on a number of representations made by the petitioner against respondents No. 6 to 8, the last one being dated 8.6.2018 (Annexure P/5). Learned counsel for the petitioner urges that the representation should be decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to the official respondents.

At this stage, on the asking of the court Mr. P.P. Chahar, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents and submits that official respondents will look into the matter and will decide the

representation of the petitioner within a period of six weeks, on receipt of certified copy of this order. Let sufficient number of copies of the paper book be supplied to him during the course of the day, failing which no action will be called for.

In view of the above, I dispose of the instant petition by directing the official respondents to decide the representation dated 8.6.2018 (Annexure P-5) of the petitioner within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.

The petition stands disposed of in the above-said terms.
