By way of filing this petition, the petitioner seeks issuance of appropriate directions to the official respondents to protect his life and liberty.

The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that respondent No.6, who is brother of the petitioner and respondent No.7, who is son of his brother are trying to illegally trespass into the property of the petitioner and to steal the standing crops. It has been submitted that respondent No.6 being in the police is using his position so as to cause undue harassment and to cause damage to the property of the petitioner.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4-Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala to look into the matter and to dispose of the representation dated 2.5.2018 (Annexure P-5), moved by the petitioner expeditiously preferably within a period of two months from receipt of copy of this order in accordance with law. In case the allegations contained therein are found to be well founded then necessary steps be taken

thereupon in accordance with law so as to ensure that no harm is caused to the petitioner or to his property, in any manner. A copy of this order alongwith representation dated 2.5.2018 (Annexure P-5) be sent to respondent No.4-Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala so as to enable him to dispose of the matter expeditiously.
