GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

The present petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No. 264 dated 12.3.2015 under Sections 323, 324 IPC, Police Station City, Panipat and proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

Vide order dated 30.7.2018 the parties had been directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate so as to get the statements recorded.

Report of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Panipat has been received to the effect that statement of complainant Surender @ Sunil Kumar and also of petitioner/accused Sushil Kumar have been recorded to

the effect that they have entered into a compromise with the intervention of respectables. The complainant has specifically stated that he has no objection if the FIR in the present case is quashed. The learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Panipat, opined that the parties have entered into the compromise voluntarily, without there being any pressure, coercion or undue influence.

In view of the aforesaid report and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the petition is allowed and FIR No. 264 dated 12.3.2015 under Sections 323, 324 IPC, Police Station City, Panipat and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
