The petitioner Nimmo has filed this petition seeking grant of regular bail in respect of a case registered against her vide FIR No.81 dated 23.6.2016 under Section 420 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Balachaur, District Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar.

The FIR, in question, was lodged at the instance of Harbhajan Kaur, who alleged that she had entered into an agreement for purchase of 9 marlas of land from the petitioner for an amount of ₹ 4.5 lacs and an earnest amount of ₹ 2.20 lacs was paid. However, the petitioner thereafter neither got the sale-deed registered on the stipulated date nor returned the amount, despite having been requested several times to do so.

The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the matter has since been compromised amongst the parties and the entire

amount, allegedly received by the petitioner, has already been returned to the complainant's daughter as the complainant has since expired. Anjana Sood, daughter of complainant Harbhajan Kaur, who is present in Court and has been identified by ASI Joginder Singh, who is also present in Court, has informed that the matter indeed been compromised and that she has received the entire amount from the petitioner and nothing is due and that she has no objection in case the petitioner is granted bail.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, and bearing in mind the fact that the petitioner is behind bars since the last about 8 months and is a lady and that the matter has been compromised amongst the parties, in my opinion it is a fit case for grant of bail to the petitioner. The present petition, as such, is accepted and the petitioner Nimmo shall be released on bail on her furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar, Punjab.

This petition stands disposed of accordingly.
