The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 0054 dated 15.6.2018, registered under Sections 363, 366, 34, 120-B IPC, Police Station Sadar Banga, District SBS Nagar.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner was not named in the FIR and the victim had made a statement that she had gone on her own and had refused her medical. The counsel further states that he was named in the supplementary statement given by the complainant.

The State counsel informs that in the supplementary statement given by the complainant the petitioner was named as having assisted the other persons in kidnapping the minor.

The victim had returned and she had made a statement that she had gone on her own. She had refused her medical. The petitioner was not named in the FIR. He was named only in the supplementary statement.

The trial will take time to conclude. Without commenting upon the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on execution of adequate personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
