This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C praying for the grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.146 dated 8.5.2014 under sections 21 of N.D.P.S Act and section 25 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station, City Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran.

On 25.8.2017, while issuing notice of motion, the following order was passed by this Court:-

“Petitioner seeks concession of pre-arrest bail in FIR No.146, dated 08.05.2014, under Section 21 of the NDPS Act and under Section 25 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station City Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that after registration of the FIR, petitioner has been granted bail and was regularly appearing before the trial Court. On ground on bona fide reasons, petitioner did not appear before the trial Court on 27.07.2017 and on account of which the concession of bail has been cancelled and bail-bonds and surety bonds have been directed to be forfeited.

Learned counsel submits that there was no intent

on the part of the petitioner to evade the trial proceedings and undertakes that the petitioner shall duly appear before the trial Court within a period of one week.

Notice of motion for 18.12.2017.

In the meanwhile, it is directed that in case the petitioner puts in appearance before the trial Court within a period of one week, he would be entitled to interim bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court”

Learned State counsel upon instructions from HC Jagjit Singh would apprise the Court that the petitioner has since put in appearance before the Trial Court and was admitted to interim bail upon furnishing requisite bail bonds/surety bonds.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined trial proceedings, the present petition is allowed. The order dated 25.8.2017, passed by this Court, is made absolute.

Petition disposed of.
