Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.110 dated 28.07.2016, registered at Police Station Sector 3, Chandigarh, under Sections 147, 149, 323, 325 and 341 IPC and Section 308 IPC added later on.

Notice of motion was issued. Learned State counsel appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the present petitioner is named in the FIR. As per the allegation, the present petitioner alongwith co-accused caused injuries to Jaspreet Singh and his friend-Sandeep. None of the injuries has been declared dangerous to life, as argued.

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The petitioner has been in custody since 25.06.2018. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping him in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
