The petitioner seeks issuance of directions to respondents No. 1 and 2 to protect her life and liberty and that of her family members.

As per counsel, brother-in-law of the petitioner namely Surender has been implicated in the FIR No. 693 dated 25.06.2018 and thereafter the petitioner and her family members are being harassed by the police for information regarding said Surender. A representation dated 07.07.2018 (Annexure P-3) has been made in this regard but no action has been taken thereupon till date. Learned counsel further points out that now aforementioned Surender has surrendered before the police but his sons, who are also named in the FIR, are still absconding and, thus, the fear of harassment still exists in the mind of the petitioner and her family members.

Notice of motion.

Mr. S.P. Singh, AAG Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Let four copies of the petition be supplied to him during the course of the day.

Considering the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to seek reply.

The petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No. 2 to objectively consider the representation dated 07.07.2018 (Annexure P-3) and to grant protection to the petitioner, in case it is felt necessary. The needful be done within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
