The petitioner herein has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 43 dated 24.1.2018, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 354, 452, 506 IPC (Section 307 IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Rai, Sonapat.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case and he is in custody since 4.2.2018. The investigation in the FIR is complete and challan has been presented. It is also argued that only general allegations have been levelled against the petitioner, whereas the co-accused, who have been attributed with kicks and fist blow have been allowed bail. The trial is likely to take some time. No useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind bars till the conclusion of the trial. He prays that the petitioner be

admitted to regular bail.

Ms. Gaganpreet Kaur, learned AAG, Haryana has contested the bail application while submitting that the allegations levelled against the petitioner are of serious nature.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Without going into the merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that the co-accused have been attributed with kicks and fist blow have been granted the benefit of bail and the trial is likely to take some time to conclude, the present petition is accepted and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
