**AMOL RATTAN SINGH, J.(ORAL)**

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Manoj Kumar, submits that all prosecution witnesses have been examined with therefore the trial virtually concluded.

In view of the above, there would be no ground to admit the petitioner to bail at this stage, with this petition therefore dismissed; with no observation made by this Court, naturally, to be taken by the trial Court to be in the context of the merits of the case for or against the petitioner.

The Superintendent of Police, Hisar, is directed to ensure that in future, as has already been directed by this Court many times in the past many years, persons who come to assist learned State counsel should at least be aware of the facts of the case and that such person should be at least of the rank of an Assistant Sub Inspector.

The SP is directed to ensure that the directions are complied with in future.
