In the instant petition, petitioners have sought for anticipatory bail in case FIR No.47 dated 05.05.2018 under Section 364 IPC registered at Police Station Ramdass, District Amritsar Rural.

2.) In support of petitioners' prayer, learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that certain FIRs were registered against the injured person by the son of the petitioners, namely, Sandeep Singh alias Amanjeet Singh. There was certain animosity between the petitioners' son and injured person. It was further submitted that petitioners' names were not reflected in FIR and it has been taken only with reference to injured person's statement dated 10.05.2018. It was also submitted that having regard to the age of the petitioners, they are entitled to relief of anticipatory bail.

3.) Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners.

4.) Petitioners had filed anticipatory bail application before the

Sessions Court and it was rejected on 24.05.2018 while taking into consideration all the factual aspects of the matter read with the seriousness of the injury. It was also noticed that allegations against the petitioners have been made by the injured/victim. In view of these facts and circumstances and the fact that injury inflicted on the person of injured are serious in nature, therefore, contention of learned counsel for the petitioners that petitioners are aged persons and so also enmity between the petitioners' son and the injured person, cannot be appreciated at this stage. Thus, petitioners have not made out a case for grant of anticipatory bail.

5.) Accordingly, petition stands dismissed.
