Petitioner-Parveen Kumar has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.15 dated 07.06.2018, registered at Police Station State Vigilance Bureau, Hisar, District Hisar, under Sections 7 and 13 of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the petitioner is not named in the FIR. He further states that main accused is Subhash

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Chander, who has already been granted regular bail by this Court vide order dated 03.08.2018 passed in CRM-M-29686-2018.

Perusal of record shows that in a trap laid by the Vigilance Department, Subhash Chander was apprehended red-handed while accepting a bribe of ₹10,000/-.

As per learned State counsel, the bribe money after accepting by Subhash Chander was handed over to the present petitioner, who was a Security Guard.

The petitioner has been in custody since 08.06.2018. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping him in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹40,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
