RAMENDRA JAIN, J. (ORAL)

Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been made for quashing FIR No.25 dated 11.03.2015 (Annexure P-1) registered under Sections 406, 419, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 474, 120-B IPC at Police Station Mullanpur Garibdas, District SAS Nagar, Mohali, on the basis of compromise dated 10.05.2017 (Annexures P-2).

2. Pursuant to order dated 25.08.2017 of this Court, the parties appeared before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate on 08.01.2018 to get their statements recorded. Learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Kharar, has submitted her report vide letter bearing No.85, dated 22.02.2018 duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, SAS Nagar, vide Endst. No.2066, dated 26.02.2018.

3. According to the report, learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class,

Kharar, is satisfied that compromise entered into between the parties is genuine, voluntary, without any coercion or undue influence with their free will.

4. Considering the report of learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Kharar, dated 22.02.2018 and the fact that the compromise will bring peace and harmony in relations between the parties, FIR No.25 dated 11.03.2015 (Annexure P-1) registered under Sections 406, 419, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 474, 120-B IPC at Police Station Mullanpur Garibdas, District SAS Nagar, Mohali, is quashed qua petitioner only, subject to payment of costs of ₹10,000/-, out of which ₹6,000/- shall be deposited with the Punjab State Legal Services Authority and ₹4,000/- with the Bar Council of Punjab and Haryana High Court.

5. Petition is disposed of accordingly.
