Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.62 dated 17.02.2017, registered at Police Station Kotwali, District Faridabad, under Sections 406, 420, 464, 465, 467, 468, 469, 471, 475, 120-B and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the petitioner was working as a Sales Officer in Shri Ram Life Insurance Company Ltd. The allegation against the petitioner is that he had sent seven proposals of dead persons

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for the insurance. However, when the claim was raised on behalf of one policy, then the said facts came to the knowledge of the Company.

Challan has already been presented. The petitioner has been in custody since 11.11.2017. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping him in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
