AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

At the joint request made by the counsel for the parties, hearing of the main case is preponed in the light of the fact that the prayer made in the petition would indicate that the petition has been rendered infructuous and an exemption is being sought by the petitioners for appearance in the Appellate Court.

Counsel for the petitioners states that in the light of the fact that the petitioners have been acquitted by the trial Court, wherein appeal has been preferred by respondent No.2, the present petition has been rendered infructuous. He prays for liberty to move an application before the Appellate Court for exemption from personal appearance of the petitioners.

The present petition is disposed of as infructuous

Liberty is, however, granted to the petitioners to move an application before the Appellate Court, which shall consider the prayer as made therein for exemption from appearance.

CRM No.15908 of 2018 stands disposed of accordingly.
