This is the second petition filed by the petitioner under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in FIR No.97 dated 27.09.2017 under Section 15 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (for short, the NDPS Act) registered at Police Station Mehna, District Moga.

The earlier petition i.e. **CRM-M-7559 of 2018** titled as ***Bhag Singh Versus State of Punjab***, wherein similar relief was claimed by the petitioner, was dismissed by this Court vide order dated 17.05.2018 by observing that in view of the recovery of contraband at the instance of the petitioner during investigation and considering the quantity of such contraband, this is not a fit case for releasing the petitioner on bail.

In the present petition, no fresh ground for releasing the petitioner on bail is made out.

Accordingly, the present petition, being devoid of any merit, is dismissed.
