By way of filing this petition, the petitioners seek transfer of the trial from Jalandhar to Jagraon on the ground that petitioner No.2 is an aged lady and that the petitioners have also to take care of two minor children and that travelling a distance of 60 kilometers is inconvenient for them.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioners, I do not find any ground for transfer of the trial. However, in case, the petitioners move an application before the learned Trial Court along with their undertaking that they have no objection for recording of evidence in their absence provided that the same be recorded in the presence of their counsel and they do not dispute their identity, such application be considered sympathetically and be disposed of expeditiously in accordance with law.
