**JAISHREE THAKUR, J. (Oral)**

The petitioner herein has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 320 dated 7.10.2017, under Sections 498-A and 306 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Hansi.

Learned counsel for the petitioner would contend that the marriage was solemnized between the petitioner and the deceased in the year 2010 and during the interregnum period, no complaint whatsoever had been lodged, while submitting that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case. It is also argued that the petitioner is in custody since 14.11.2017 and the complainant has been examined and, therefore, there is no likelihood of the petitioner to influence any witness. It is further submitted that only one witness out of 12 has been examined as on date. The trial is

likely to take some time. No useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind bars till the conclusion of the trial. He prays that the petitioner be admitted to regular bail.

Mr. P.P. Chahar, learned DAG, Haryana opposes the bail application, while submitting that the allegations levelled against the petitioner are of serious nature.

Without going into the merits of the case and keeping in view the facts that the complainant has been examined; the petitioner is in custody since 14.11.2017; only one witness out of 12 has been examined as on date and the trial is likely to take some time to conclude, the present petition is accepted and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
