The petitioners have approached this Court seeking protection of their life and liberty on the premise that petitioner No.1 has performed marriage with petitioner No.2 against the wishes of her parents and other family members and the petitioners are apprehending threat to their life and liberty at their instance.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Joginder Pal Ratra, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent – State.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has placed on record the certificate issued by the Central Board of Secondary Education of petitioner No.1 regarding her date of birth. It is further submitted that the petitioners have given a representation dated 28.07.2018 to the Senior Superintendent of Police, S.A.S. Nagar, Mohali (Annexure P4) seeking necessary protection but no action has been taken so far in the

matter.

Heard.

Without examining the question of validity or otherwise of marriage of the petitioners, the present petition stands disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, S.A.S. Nagar Mohali to look into the grievance of the petitioners expressed in the representation (Annexure P4) and take appropriate action, if any, warranted in the circumstances.
