Petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail under the provisions of Section 438 Cr.P.C. in FIR No.101 dated 24.06.2018 under Sections 420/467/468/471 IPC, registered at Police Station Beas, District Amritsar Rural (Annexure P-1).

2.) This Court vide order dated 31.07.2018 had directed the petitioner to join investigation and in the event of arrest by the Arresting/Investigating Officer, petitioner was ordered to be released on interim bail on his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer.

3.) Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Manohar Lal, submitted that in pursuance to the order dated 31.07.2018, petitioner

appeared before the Arresting/Investigating Officer and joined the investigation. It is further submitted that petitioner is not required for custodial interrogation in the present case.

4.) In view of these facts and circumstances, without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, the order dated 31.07.2018, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is hereby made absolute. Petitioner shall remain bound by the conditions as envisaged in Section 438 (2) of Cr.P.C.

5.) The petitioner shall not in any way indulge in any criminal activities and he shall not influence the witnesses or otherwise interfere with the fair trial.

6.) Petition stands allowed.
