The petitioner has filed present petition under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.97 dated 22.03.2018 under Sections 193, 196, 419, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Division No.5, District Ludhiana.

Memo of appearance filed on behalf of the complainant in Court today, is taken on record.

The allegation against the petitioner is that the petitioner had filed a civil suit against the complainant and in order to get the stay order from the civil Court, he along with other co-accused misled the civil Court by placing on record forged and fabricated documents and caused wrongful loss

to the complainant. The said documents were sent to the Forensic Science Laboratory, Punjab, where the signatures of the complainant did not tally.

Therefore, keeping in view the seriousness of the offence allegedly committed by the petitioner, this Court finds that no ground for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made out.

Accordingly, the present petition, being devoid of any merit, is dismissed.
