The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.73 dated 20.07.2014 under Sections 323/324/506/148/149 of the IPC and Sections 307/326 of the IPC (added later on), registered at Police Station Arni Wala, District Fazilka, Punjab.

2.) Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that in the present case, police filed cancellation report but the Trial Court refused to accept the report and ordered to summon the accused to face trial.

3.) This Court vide order dated 28.08.2017 had directed the petitioner to surrender before the Trial Court, on doing so, he was ordered to be released on ad interim bail on his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Trial Court.

4.) Learned State counsel, on instructions from Head Constable

Gurcharan Singh states that in pursuance to the order dated 28.08.2017 petitioner appeared before the Trial Court. That apart observations made by this court in the order dated 28.08.2017 have gone un rebutted.

5.) In view of these facts and circumstances, without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, the order dated 28.08.2017, granting ad interim bail to the petitioner, is hereby made absolute.

6.) The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
