Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of petitioners and to provide them adequate security so that respondents No.4 to 6 and other relatives of petitioners do not interfere in the married life of the petitioners.

On notice of motion having been issued, learned State counsel has filed affidavit of Lakhvir Singh Tiwana, PPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police (North), Ludhiana, in court today on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3, which is taken on record. The affidavit is accompanied with a true copy of statement of Sonam Kumari alias Sonam i.e. petitioner No.1. The statement reads as under:-

“Stated that I am residing at the above noted address and my entire family i.e. mother, father and brother reside at Bihar. On 27.07.2018 I had performed marriage with Parvez Rain S/o Aslam Rain, R/o H.No.1707/5E/3b,

Street No.3 Manjit Nagar, Ludhiana. Earlier before my marriage, my family members had come to Ludhiana and therefore I had apprehended danger from them but now my entire family members have gone back to Bihar. Now I have no danger from anybody nor I want to get any police security. I am residing happily with my husband. Statement has been got recorded, heard which is correct.”

The perusal of above statement shows that the parents of petitioner No.1, before her marriage had come to Ludhiana and, therefore, the petitioners apprehended danger to their lives, but now the entire family has gone to Bihar, she does not apprehend any threat and is not in need of police security.

In view of statement so made by petitioner No.1 on 15.08.2018 (Annexure R-1/T), present petition is rendered infructuous and disposed of as such.
