The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 1267 dated 27.09.2016, registered under Section 7-A of the Haryana Development and Regulation of Urban Areas Act, 1975 at Police Station Panipat City, District Panipat.

The operative part of the order dated 01.08.2018, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in fact, has acquired her share in the land by way of exchange and subsequent thereto, neither she has sold any part of her share nor has raised any construction.

Notice of motion for 15.10.2018.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 01.08.2018, has already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from SI Daljeet

Singh, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 01.08.2018, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
