In the instant petition, petitioner has sought for regular bail under the provision of Section 439 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.28 dated 25.03.2018 under Section 22 of NDPS Act registered at Police Station Chohla Sahib, District Tarn Taran.

2. In support of his grievances, learned counsel for the petitioner relied on decision passed in 'Inderjit Singh @ Laddi and others Vs. State of Punjab', 2014 (3) RCR (Criminal) Page 953, as the report from the Chemical Examiner has not yet been received.

3. Learned State counsel has not disputed the aforesaid facts as well as factual position of this case.

4. In view of these facts and circumstances, the petitioner is entitled to regular bail. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. Petitioner, namely, Amarjit Singh @ Mithu is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of concerned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.

5. However, the petitioner shall not in any way indulge in any criminal activities and he shall also not influence the witnesses or other wise interfere with the fair trial.
