Learned counsel for the petitioner states that similarly situated co-accused has already been admitted on bail by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Faridabad and therefore, he be permitted to withdraw the present petition, however, with liberty to approach the trial Court for the aforesaid relief so as to claim parity or any other ground whatsoever.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty, as prayed for.

The petitioner is at liberty to file a fresh petition seeking regular bail on the ground that his co-accused has been admitted on bail. He is at liberty to claim parity and the Court shall analyse the same in accordance with law.
