The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.129 dated 24.10.2017, registered under Sections 395, 450, 411, 341, 506, 201 IPC and Section 27 of the Arms Act at Police Station Islamabad, District Amritsar.

Briefly stated, it is a case of the prosecution that victim was a medical practitioner. On the intervening night of 23/24.10.2017 at about 12:25 a.m., someone knocked the door. When the complainant opened the door, he found the petitioner in front of him. She was complaining severe pain in her abdomen and she requested the victim to provide her medicines. She was also accompanied by one person.

When the victim came inside then 5-7 unknown persons having muffled faces entered his house. Out of them, one person was having dattar (an instrument of cutting) and the other two persons were having revolvers. All of them put the victim under threat and tied his mouth and arms. Then all the desperadoes committed robbery. They took

out Rs.10,000/- from the cash box, Rs.1,50,000/- from the almirah and 12 tolas gold ornaments. While escaping from the spot, they took mobile phone and digital video recording (DVR) of the CCTV camera. After his arrest Rs.6800/- was recovered from the petitioner.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have gone through the record.

The allegations against the petitioners are serious in nature. Her identification being a robber has been established.

Keeping in view the seriousness of the offence and the totality of the circumstances of the case, this court is of the view that the petitioner is not entitled to the benefit of bail.

Therefore, the instant petition stands dismissed.
