Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of appropriate directions to respondents No. 2 to 4 for taking appropriate action in the matter since respondents No. 5 to 8 have been making false complaints at different Police Stations and attempts are being made to rope the petitioner and her family members in false criminal cases.

Prayer made in the petition in itself is innocuous. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that his prayer is based on apprehension of the petitioner that she might be involved in some false case however, so far, no case false or correct, is stated to have been registered against the present petitioner. There cannot be any pre-emption against the police preventing them not to register an FIR against the petitioner. If and when any action is taken by the Police against the petitioner or his family members, she will avail her alternate remedy in accordance with law.

In view of the above, this Court does not find merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
